- Tranquillization to prepare anaesthesia
- To reduce the dosage of anaesthetics
- To reduce postoperative vomiting
- Pains after operations

Illnesses of the eye

- Allergies
- Inflammations:
- Eyelid, conjunctiva, retina,
- iris
- seeing disorders, amblyopia (supportive)
- Glaucoma
- Dry eyes

Bronchial and lung diseases

- Allergies
- Asthma
- Illnesses of the bronchial system
- Pneumonia (especially its consequences)
- Croup

Gynaecological diseases


- Breasts, ovary, fallopian tube, uterus
- Inflammations
- migraine (hormonal)
- Irritable bladder
- pregnancy/childbirth:
- pregnancy discomfort (eating disorders, pains, nausea, sickness)
- dehabituating of nicotine during pregnancy, to influence pathologic foetal lie (E. g. Breech presentation)
- preparation for the birth, induction of labour, birtheasement
- Lactation disorders
- Pains due to haemorrhoids
- Episotomy, Caesarian section, Afterpains

Disorders:

- Fertility, Libido,
- Menstruation (Regulation, pains),
- Menopause

Skin diseases

- Acne
- Allergies
- eczemas
- ulcers
- herpes
- neurodermatitis
- psoriasis
- wounds (hard recovery)



Cardiovascular diseases

- Bloodpressure problems
- Bloodcirculation disorders
- functional heart disorders
- disorders of the rhythm of the heart

Otorhinolaryngological illnesses

- Allergies, hay fever
- immune weakness:
- chronic inflammations (tonsillitis, middle ear, sinusitis) common colds
- smell and taste disorders
- Facial nerve paralysis
- Sudden hearing loss /Tinnitus
- Illnesses of the windpipes
- Ménière`s disease
- mouth and pharyngal dryness
- Motionsickness
- Hardness of hearing
- dizziness
- Illnesses of the salivary glands
- speech development disorders
- Voice and speech disorders

Children's diseases

- Allergies
- Asthma
- Eczema, Neurodermatitis
- Epilepsy/ convulsion disorder
- developmental disorders
- bed-wetting,
- Hyperactivity
- Concentration disorders
- Susceptibility to infections /Inflammations
- common cold, coughing, tonsils,
- paranasal sinuses, ears, bladder
- croup
- sleeping disorders

Gastro-intestinal diseases

- regurgitation, hiccup, heartburn
- diarrhoea
- sickness, nausea
- Inflammations of the Gall bladder, and the biliary tract
- Liver diseases (e.g. hepatitis)
- Peptic ulcer
- Crohn`s disease, ulcerative colitis
- absence of acids
- constipation

Neurological diseases

- acroparaesthesia
- consequences of infantile paralysis
- facial nerve paralysis
- Headaches, migraines
- Epilepsy /convulsion disorder
- Paralysis (after stroke)
- Neuralgia
- phantompain
- polyneuropathy
- Pains (e. g. After shingles)
- tinnitus
- trigeminal neuralgia
- Vegetative dysfunctions

Orthopaedic diseases

- Complains /inflammations/ pains of the joints, (acute and chronic), muscles (tensions), strings and ligaments.
- fibromialgia
- carpal tunnel syndrome
- rheumatism
- Complex Regional Pain Syndrome (CRPS)
- Tietze-syndrome
- synovial cyst
- spinal column:
- scoliosis, wry neck
- intervertebral disc, nerve root irritation
- Bechterew's disease

Mental illnesses

- depressive upsets
- General fatigue
- Eating disorders; anorexia, Bulimia, overweight
- Psychovegetative and psychosomatic illnesses
- Sleep disturbances
- Addiction treatment: alcohol, drugs, Nicotine,
- Restlessness

Urological and nephrological diseases

- Bed-wetting
- Inflammations: bladder, kidneys, renal pelvis, prostate
- Urinary incontinence
- Impotence
- Irritable bladder
- Pains through kidney stones/ uteral calculus

Tooth /Mouth/ Jaw diseases

- amalgam restoration
- sensitive teeth
- dysgeusia
- herpes, aphtae
- jaw joint disorders: radiating pain,
- teeth grinding
- paradontosis, Inflammation of the gums
- Prothesis incompatibility
- pharyngeal reflex by dental treatment
- toothache

Other indications

- collapse (supportive)
- Pains due to cancer
- state of shock (supportive)strong
